PHIGA was established in 2017 as the educational arm of Center Point International, a Christian non-governmental organization founded by a Liberian Educator, Tony Weedor. and his wife, Mrs. Elizabeth Fahn Weedor, Author, and International Speaker. Elizabeth, who is the founder and executive Director of the school. obtained her early education through the courageous and financial assistance of her dearest grandmother, Madame Maima Kai, Ma Maima, as commonly called, stood fearlessly against her maledominant society to make education a priority for her granddaughters and a dedicated advocate for women in her district. Today, Elizabeth is benefiting from her grandmother's determination to give a girl an education. As a result of her grandmother's bold stance on impacting women and girls in her own culture and village, Elizabeth is devoted to do likewise for girls and women who find themselves in similar traditional practices and worldviews in Liberia and hopes to extend to other parts of Africa.

PHI is an all-girl primary school that has become an integral part of the growing community of Advent Hill-Schiefflin Town in Margibi County.

PHI-2 Phase two of the school has just been completed in the R-2 Community of PAYNESVILLE, suburbs of Monrovia for both boys and girls: "PETALS OF HOPE INTERNATIONAL CHRISTIAN ACADEMY," (PHICA-2). Enrollment started 2/08/2021 and the school opened on the 2/09/2021.

The School offers a student-friendly and inclusive environment where individual excellence is celebrated, Christian character is developed, and each student is encouraged to be a life-long learner, able to effectively work with others.

Our programs are structured and designed to fulfill the physical, academic, emotional, psychological, and spiritual needs of our students. Learning at PHI is individualized-adjusted to the abilities, interests, and learning style of each student. Our vision is global, yet global in its perspectives.

We have committed, professional and experienced teachers and a dedicated support staff whose collective efforts, love, and care position PHI as a home away from home: a center for knowledge sharing and social skills cultivation.

Our Mission

We exist to work with communities to prevent sex trafficking, inequality of girls and women, and to restore lives through excellent education. We hope to build safe homes, rescue, and shelter girls who are trapped into sexual violence, and other abuses. Our final objective is to restore and reintegrate them into their own communities and society with better life skills that would give them independence, self-esteem, and self-sustainability, with firmed Christian characters.
